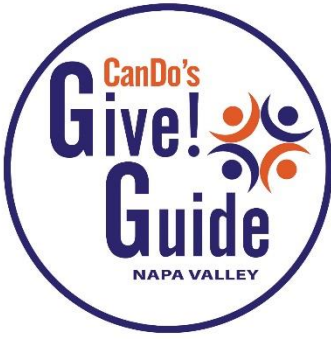

Sing Napa Valley proudly presents three performances in the fall of 2024 to celebrate the conclusion of its Sixtieth Anniversary Year of concerts in every year since its inception!

The first of the three performances is a fundraising salon, titled AUTUMN MASQUERADE - Celebrating the Change of Season with a Little of the Macabre - on Sunday, October 20, at 3 pm at the American Legion Hall, 1240 Pearl Street, in Napa. Tickets, at \$30 each, can be purchased in advance online at www.singnapavalley.org or by texting snvfall to 41444. Seating is limited, so we suggest you procure your tickets well in advance of the performance. Any remaining tickets may be available for purchase at the door on concert day. Music on a decidedly autumn theme including the celebrated macabre holiday theme of Halloween will be presented by a SNV ensemble along with associated vocal soloists. There will be a Cash Bar and a Silent Auction along with amazing entertainment!!!

The second fundraising salon, titled BRIGHT IS THE RING OF WORDS (*AND MUSIC TOO!*) on Sunday, November 10, at 3pm at Napa Methodist Church, 625 Randolph St. at Fifth St. Featuring lyric soprano Anne Marie Carden of Boston, who has a Master of Music in vocal performance from Boston Conservatory of Music, joined by Napa's own bass-baritone Ben Covone, performing opera arias and art songs with collaborative pianist Ellen Patterson. And classical accordionist Mary Ann Covone (Ben's sister) of Chicago, president emeritus of the national Accordionists and Teachers Guild and is an acclaimed performer of classical music for accordion as well as the Founder/Director of the Chicagoland Accordion Academy.

The last celebratory performance of the 60th Anniversary season is Sing Napa Valley's annual holiday concert, titled JOY TO THE WHOLE WORLD, featuring *Let the Whole World Sing* by Joel Raney, at CrossWalk Community Church on First St. in Napa. The featured piece is full of holiday songs and creative arrangements of many of the most familiar carols and seasonal songs. In addition, the chorus will perform independent holiday songs and will invite the audience to join them in a few traditional, familiar carols that are not included in *Let the Whole World Sing*. This will be a light-hearted & fun program designed to bring joy to our entire world for Napa and beyond!
